TESTIMONY

On March 31, 2023, at 2:31pm, my family experienced something you never can quite prepare for. By the grace of God, my children and I were home, huddled in our bathtub as an F3 tornado ripped down our street. In a matter of seconds, our beautiful neighborhood, known for its mature trees, looked like an absolute disaster area—unrecognizable and disorienting for every resident. I remember walking out of the bathroom and seeing my home destroyed, but thanking God for His ever evident hand over us, keeping us completely safe. Within minutes, my husband and our pastor, Harry Bates, were banging at our front door to bring us to safety. There was nothing safe about that environment.

I will never forget how within the hour, I started to see red SERVE shirts flood the area. There were people from my Life Group at my driveway starting to pack and pull my belongings out of my house, men with chainsaws clearing debris, and others who were running to our neighbors' homes to assist them. As I walked down my cherished street the next morning, the devastation was completely overwhelming. I cried uncontrollably as I saw my pastors and church family coming towards me, having already been at my home working long before I had arrived. They held us, hugged us, and did the hard work of walking with us through an experience that could have crushed us. Within one day, our home was packed up and put in storage. The church stayed by our side, not for days, but for weeks and months as we slowly recovered and restored. Over the course of months, so many were the actual hands and feet of God's love for our community. We saw God's tangible faithfulness through the church at large, running into the mess, the hurt, the hard, and lifting up the name of Jesus, carrying His hope in every interaction. We are forever grateful for our church family and the way we experienced God's love through it all.


