TRANSITION: SPEND SOME TIME IN WORSHIP & PRAYER

30-45 MIN | WHAT IS YOUR LEGACY?

PROVERBS 13:22

Q1. What does it mean to have a legacy? What are some examples of legacies that people have left?

- Your life makes a difference after you are gone.

JUDGES 2:10

- “You Just Do You,” “Live Your Own Truth,” today’s expressions that sound like ancient Israel: “doing what was right in their own eyes.”

Q2. At what point in your life did you have an option to choose God or something else? What did you do that changed the course of your life and maybe your legacy?

- God always gives you an option that you can change your life and your legacy.

1 CHRONICLES 7:40 (Asher changed the legacy he was given)

- Your past doesn't have to determine your future

THREE CORE QUESTIONS IF YOU ARE GOING TO HAVE A LEGACY

CORE Q1. What Will Be Your Legacy Of Faith?

2 TIMOTHY 1:4-5

- We believe even when we do not see.

HEBREWS 11:1

- Faith is visualizing the future. Visualizing potential. Seeing things in advance.

Q3. When has God asked you to take a walk of faith? (Noah was the example shared).

- We obey even when we do not understand
- When your life is in transition, trust a good God.
- He wants our relationship to be a walk of faith.

HEBREWS 11:7

Q4. Are you ready to trust God in advance? Do you trust your gut or God? God's word or the world?

- Faith trusts God even when you do not understand it.

CORE Q2. What Will Be Your Legacy Of Convictions?

- Convictions are values that get deep down.
- Convictions are things you would die for.
- Convictions are what is going to guide your life. (Not the easiest thing to do or what everyone else is doing)
- When you live by convictions you are going to be criticized. You will make other people uncomfortable.

ROMANS 11:36

> Conviction example: Life is all about God. What we love most.

- When you have first love, that love will draw you back into the presence of the one you love: A guiding force.

CORE Q3. What Will Be Your Legacy Of Giving?

- Generosity in your life.
- Love says I want to give something to you.
- Lust says I want to get something, I want my needs met.
- This giving is the heart and character of God.

JOHN 1:16

Q5. If you do not have a generous spirit, how can you change that? What one step can you take this week? (IE: pray)

- Next week there will be a legacy offering.
- God takes your money and does something supernatural with it.

LUKE 16:9

- God takes money and he turns it into souls.
- Pray for your offering next week.

2 COR: 9:7

- As Life Group leaders—the hands, feet and voice of Jesus—remember “CPR”:

 - › Do not share anything that will embarrass anyone, including your spouse.
 - › If called on you may pass on any questions you do not want to answer.
 - › Allow time for everyone to share; do not dominate the conversation.
 - › What is said in the group stays in the group. Use common sense and know when something shared is personal and should remain confidential.
